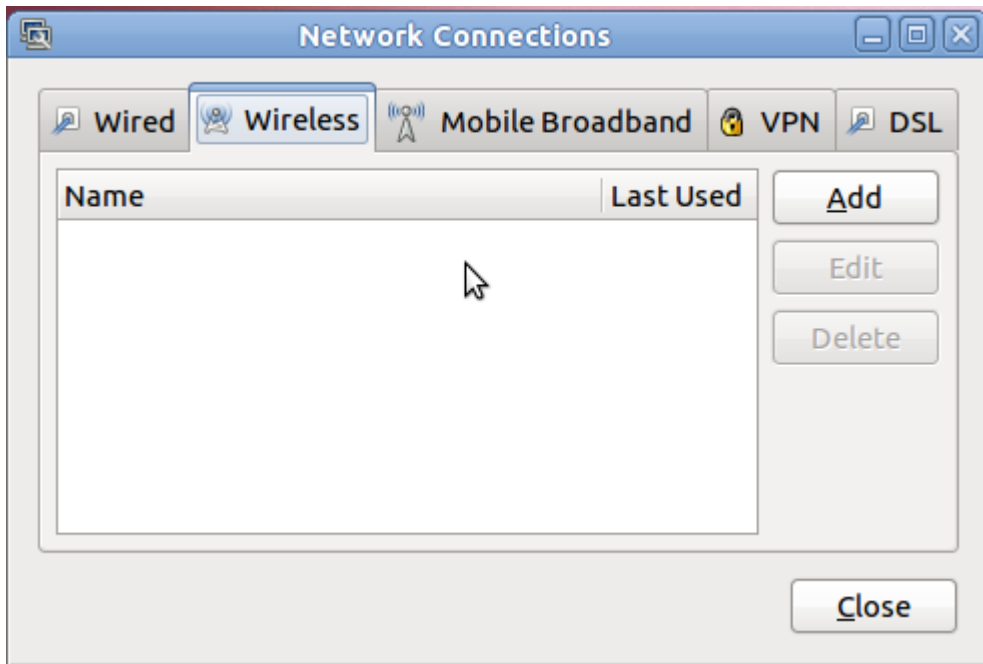
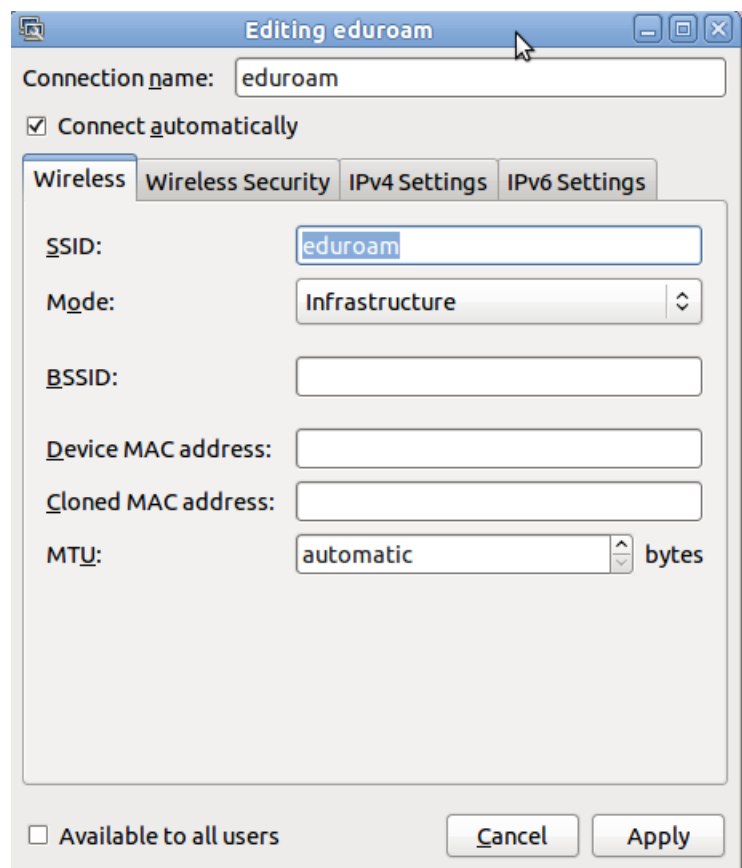


Eduroam for Linux

1. Start by downloading the certificate file "<https://tcs.sunet.se/info/AddTrust-External-CA-Root.crt>" and save it in some suitable place.
2. Start Network Manager
For Ubuntu:
System → Preferences → Network Connections



3. Choose "Add"
4. Name your connection "eduroam".
5. Under the tab "Wireless" fill in SSID = eduroam



6. Under the tab "Wireless Security" fill in:
 - Security = WPA & WPA2 Enterprise
 - Authentication = Protected EAP (PEAP)
 - CA Certificate = should point to the file you downloaded at the beginning
 - Username = your user id followed by *@ad.bth.se* or *@students.ad.bth.se*.
 - Password = your usual AD domain password.
7. Click "Apply".
