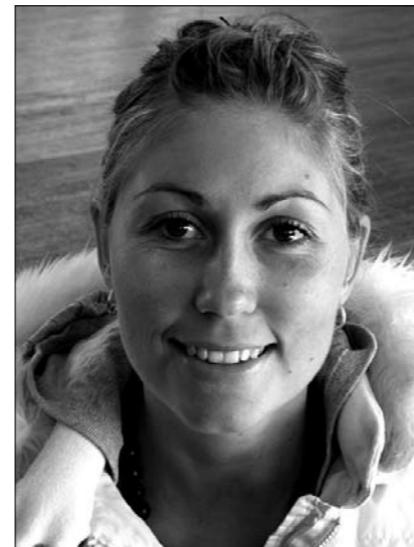

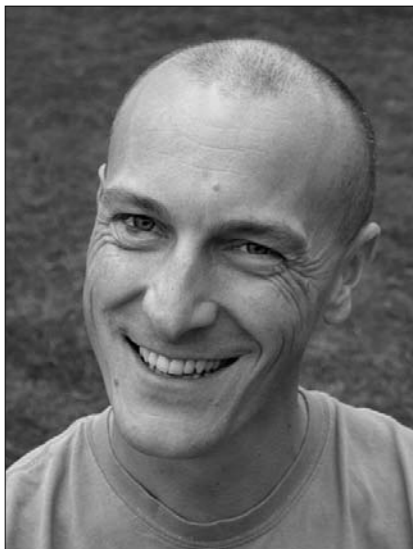

Mohammed Ismaeil Basheer Ireg ·

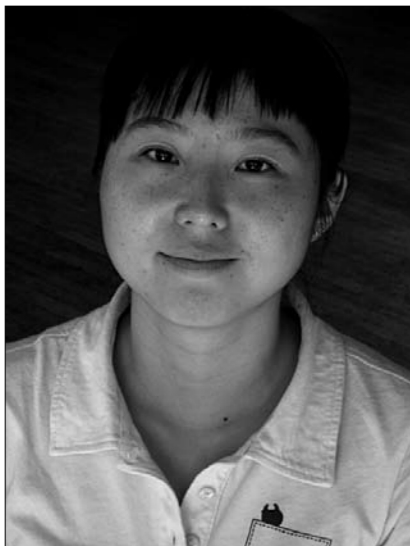

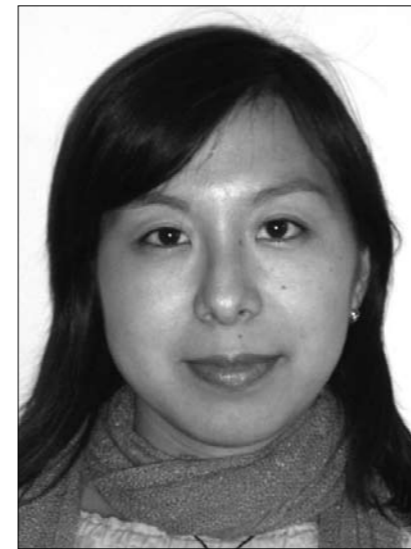

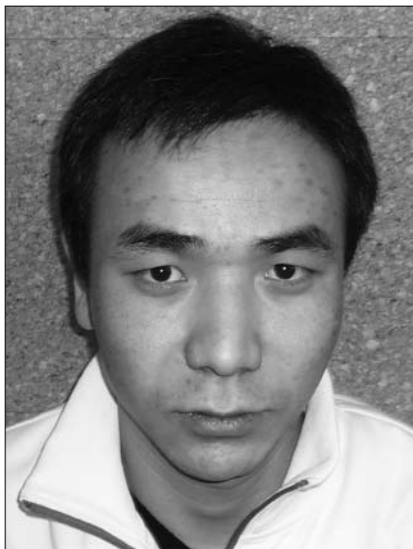
