Credit system	Sweden has a system of credits (högskolepoäng); a normal 40-week academic year corresponds to 60 credits. The system is compatible with ECTS credits (European Credit Transfer System).
Grading system	At BTH, one of the following scales is to be employed: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ G, Ux, U (G Pass, Ux Insufficient, supplementation required, U Fail) ▪ A, B, C, D, E, FX, F (A Excellent, B Very good, C Good, D Satisfactory, E Sufficient, FX Insufficient, supplementation required, F Fail).

	Grades are given for course items and for complete courses, by the examiner.
